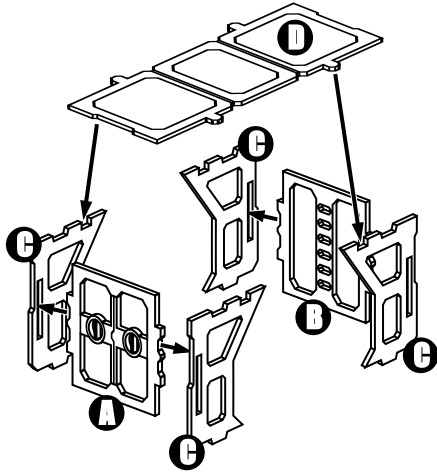


IN-City Industrial Shipping Container

Assembly



1. After removing all pieces from the sheet, assemble parts "A" and "B" to the 4 parts "C"
2. Glue both end assemblies to the top (part "D")
3. Fold card box and prime all parts before gluing the card box into the MDF frame.
4. Paint the box and the frame in desired colors. Use the included stencil to add panels onto the sides of the box.
5. Glue the box into the frame and add weathering effects as desired.

Important Tips

1. When gluing the box into the frame, be careful not to get glue onto places on your box that will be exposed if you have already painted it.
2. When gluing the box into the frame, also squeeze the small sides together to make sure that the feet will line up with the slots making them stackable.
2. Use a ripped up piece of open-cell foam to dab dark brown paint along the edges to give the look of paint chips and rusty spots.
3. Some spray-paints may make some of the fiber of the card stand up. If this happens, simply let the paint dry fully and wipe it down with a lint-free cloth or a gloved hand. The fibers usually become brittle with dry paint and brush away easily. If this happens, it is typically only on the first coat.
